Action Item

Proposal:

That the Board of Trustees approve a BFGC Project Assignment Amendment (PAA) – Infrastructure Upgrades.

Background:

At the November 8, 2005 Board meeting, the Board ratified an On-Going Architectural Services Agreement with BFGC Architects, Inc. The Agreement stipulates that for each individual District project, a separate Project Assignment Amendment (PAA) will be entered into. The attached PAA is for the Infrastructure Upgrades project.

This project includes replacement, augmentation and repair of the campus wide infrastructure which supports all activities on the Gavilan campus. A new loop distribution pathway for information technology, electrical and fire alarm systems will be the backbone of the project. Gas and electrical service will be replaced and augmented. The boilers in the Physical Science, Business and Gymnasium Buildings will be replaced. The sanitary sewer and storm drain systems will be repaired and cleaned. Site security lighting will be augmented and replaced. The Network Operations Center and MIS staff will be relocated from the Library to the present Occupational Education Building. Due to the deteriorated condition of the existing boilers, a separate State-emergency construction-package is being prepared for boiler replacement.

The current water tank replacement is the subject of a separate State-emergency funding application, which will be treated as a separate, stand-alone project, including controls.

Budgetary Implications:

This agreement will be paid out of the proceeds of Measure E funds.
