

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

### Gavilan Joint Community College District Coyote Community College Campus

*Notice is hereby given* that the Board of Trustees of the Gavilan Community College District (“Board”) will hold a public hearing on the proposed Coyote Community College Campus Project (“Project”). The public hearing will be held on September 9, 2008 at 7:00 P.M. (or as soon thereafter as possible) in the Student Center of the Gavilan Community College, 5055 Santa Teresa Boulevard, Gilroy, California. At the public hearing, the Board will consider the certification of the Final Environmental Impact Report (“Final EIR”) pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, and the approval of the Project.

**Project Description:** The project consists of the acquisition of approximately 55 acres in the Coyote Valley area of the City of San José by the Gavilan Community College District and the development and operation of a community college campus on the site. The site is located in south San José, near the north end of Coyote Valley, on the south side of Bailey Avenue between the Santa Teresa Hills on the west and Fisher Creek on the east. The site is approximately 1.8 miles southwest of the Bailey Avenue/Highway 101 interchange.

The college campus would be developed in multiple phases over a 20-year (or longer) period. The Project would accommodate up to 10,000 students. The actual timing of construction will be dependent upon enrollment growth and funding availability.
