- Complete the online scholarship application.

If you are not currently enrolled for fall 2018 or spring 2019 semesters but plan to attend next year, please apply for Admission for summer 2019 or fall 2019 semesters. Once admitted, you will be sent your Gavilan ID# and be able to apply for our scholarship program.
