

## Program and Certificate Awards for Gavilan College, 2004-2005

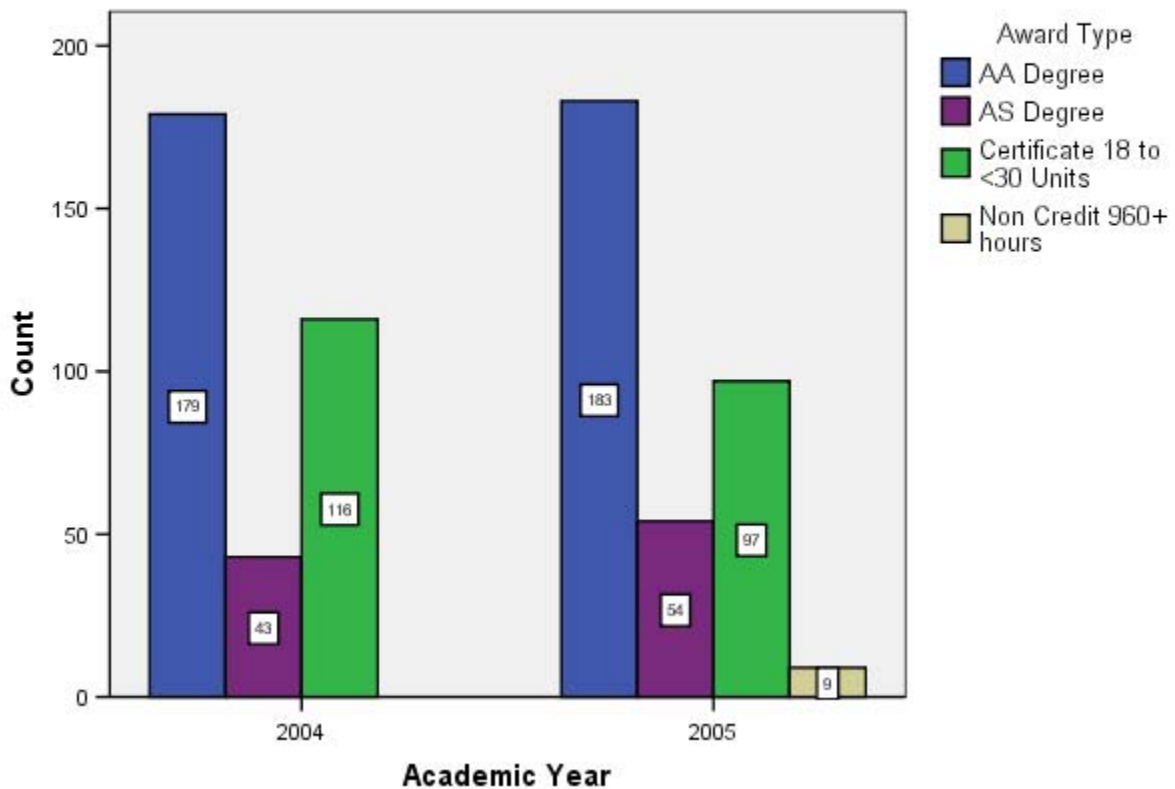
### Summary of Findings

A total of 681 awards were granted to Gavilan College students in academic years 2004 and 2005.

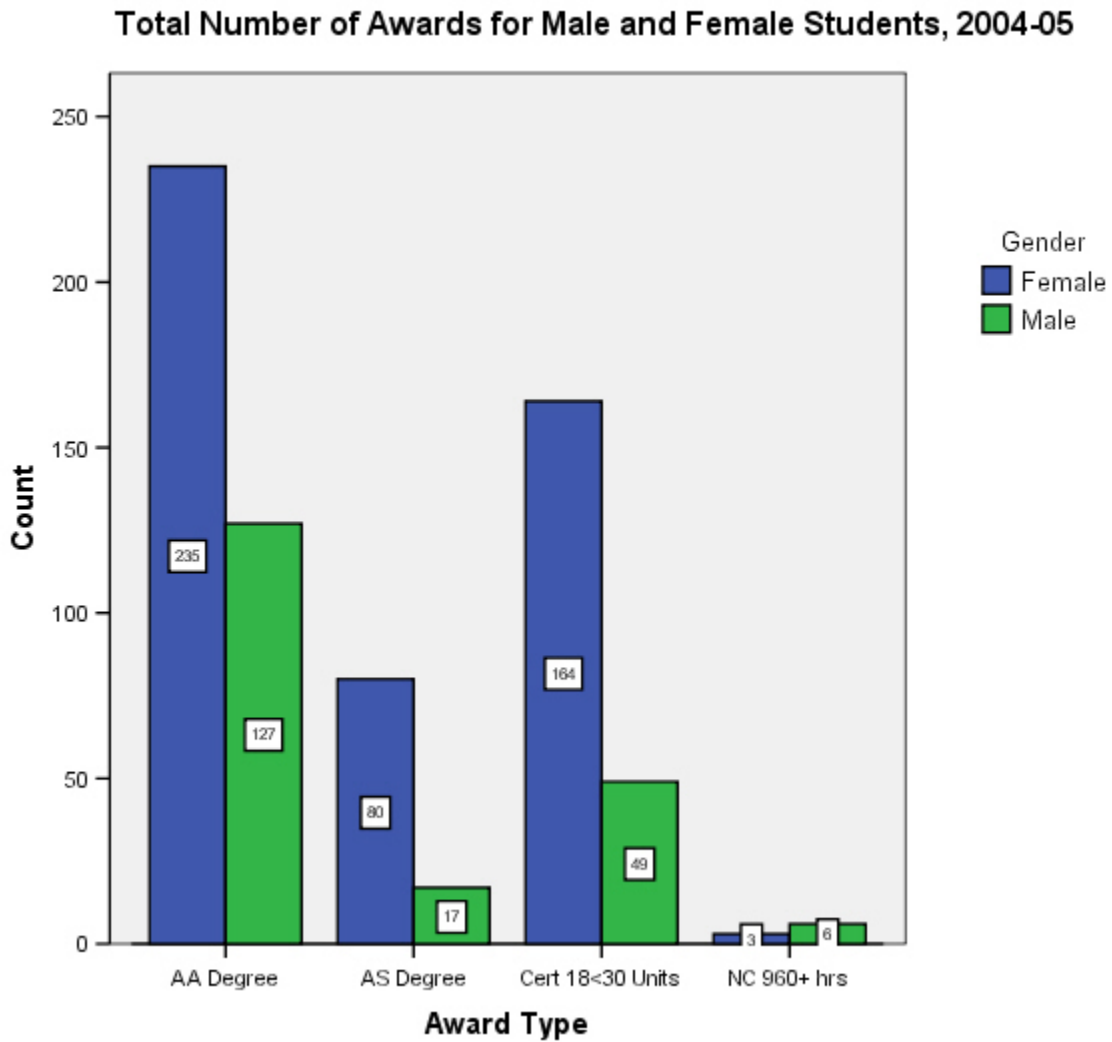
**Number of Awards by Type, 2004-2005**

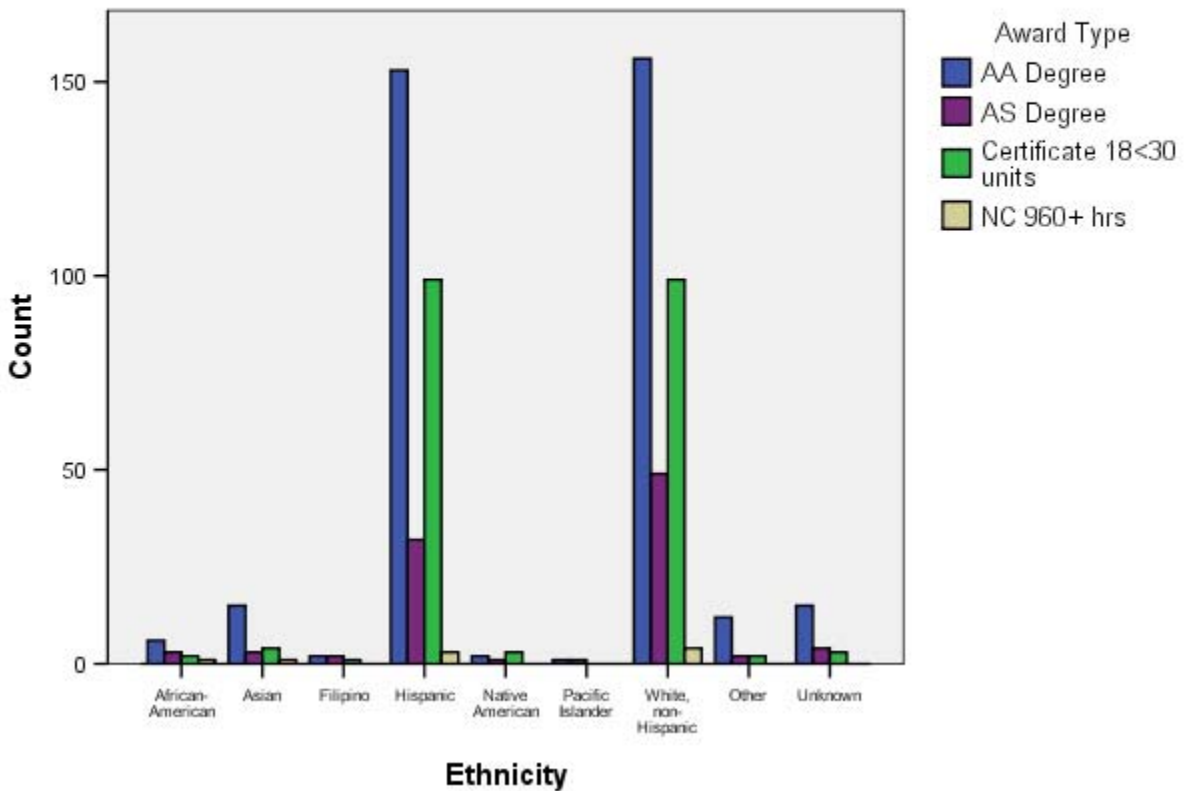


**Awards by Ethnicity**

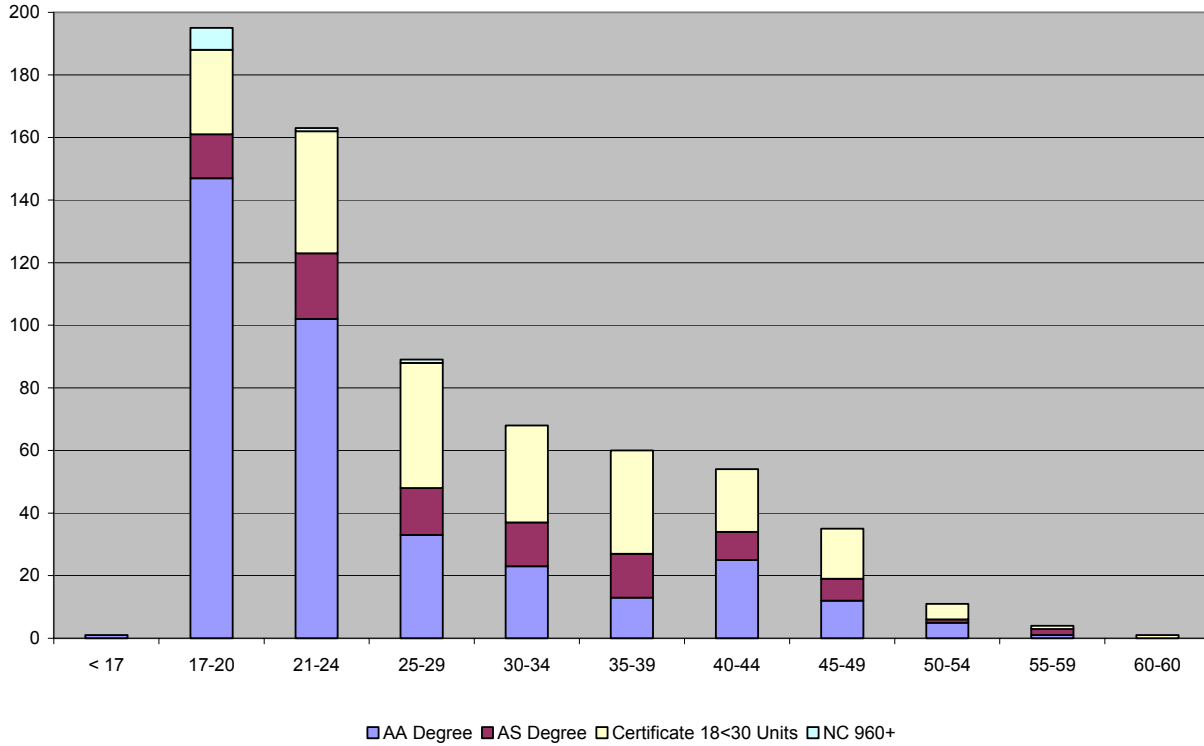
**Total Number of Awards by Ethnicity, 2004-05**
