STEM

- We had 58 students apply for STEM summer internships, more than triple the previous year!
- MESA Rising Stars event recognized MESA students on March 26th who have completed 30+ units with 3.0 GPA. 18 out of 40 students were able to attend with friends and family to celebrate their achievement.



Library & Distance Education

- We awarded our first “Quality Reviewed” online course badge to Catherine Miller for her CD/PSYCH 2 - Early Childhood Development course, signifying it meets the highest online teaching standards in the state. We’re working to make sure deans and department chairs know of these awarded classes so they can be scheduled, and we can start collecting data to assess effectiveness of the POCR program.
- We have 19 more courses/teachers on the review schedule and about 6 more ready to receive the Quality Review award in the next week or two.

- Bach to Blues was a great success! Thanks to all those who attended on March 16th. The event raised over \$1,500 which will go towards the Gavilan Music Program.

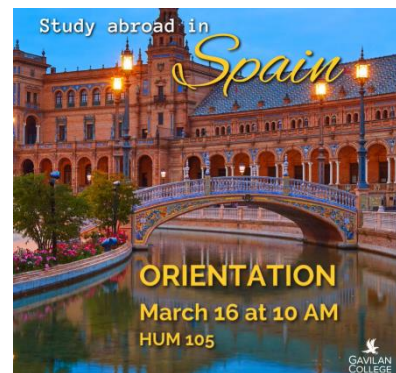


Film & Television
