

ALLIED HEALTH (NURSING)

AH 182: Home Health Care

Transferable: CSU

This two (2) week, eight (8) day course is designed to prepare students to provide basic health care in the home environment. This course includes interpretation of medical/social needs, personal care services, cleaning tasks, nutrition, and the scope of limitations of a home health aide. All students who achieve a grade of "C" or better will be eligible for a Home Health Aide Certificate from the State of California Department of Public Health. PREREQUISITE: Active California C.N.A. certification or successful completion with a minimum score of 75% or equivalent in AH 180. Also, eligible for English 250 and English 260. Clearance from the Department of Health Services (Form HS283B), fingerprint clearance, negative drug screen, required immunizations, negative TB screen, and health clearance required prior to clinical placement.
