REGISTRATION PERIOD	DATE	WHO CAN REGISTER?
Priority 1	Nov 23-25	CalWORKS, DRC, EOPS, Foster Youth, Veterans (see notes below for additional eligibility criteria)
Priority 2	Nov 30	Athletes, MESA, Puente, TRIO (see notes below for additional eligibility criteria)
Priority 3	Dec 1-2	Continuing, new to college who have completed orientation/assessment/ed plan, GECA (see notes below for additional eligibility criteria)
Priority 4	Dec 3	New to college students (1 st . semester), and beyond who have not completed assessment/orientation/ed plan
Priority 5	Dec 4-Jan 31	Returning, Transfer, Academically Dismissed, High School (except GECA)
Late	Feb 1- Feb 12	Students who have obtained add codes from instructors
Open – entry/late-start	Before first day of class	All students taking open-entry and late-start classes

NOTES:

- Eligible Continuing students during Priority 1, 2, or 3 registration must be in good academic standing e.g. not on probation for 2 consecutive semesters or dismissal and have less than 100 earned units total excluding 30 units basic skills or ESL classes.
- New to college students for Spring 2016, and who are eligible for Priority 1, 2, or 3 registrations, must have successfully completed an assessment, education plan and orientation to be eligible for priority registration. Those who have not successfully completed an assessment, education plan and orientation may enroll during Priority 4 registration which starts on Dec 3.

NOTE: Students must pay for ALL classes, for Spring, including classes added after initial registration to prevent being dropped from classes during the drop for nonpayment dates listed above. If students do not pay ALL fees and the outstanding balance on their account, they will be dropped from ALL Spring Classes.

All students may go online to purchase a parking permit. Students can print out a temporary permit to use while waiting to receive the official permit in the mail.
