of "C" or better before the IGETC can be certified. See requirements for partial IGETC certification in catalog. A student is strongly advised to complete a total of 60 transferable units before transferring. These will include the IGETC requirements, "major" prerequisites, and elective elective courses if needed. (Students must request an IGETC certification from the Office of Admissions and Records before transferring.)

- A single course, even though listed in more than one place, can only be used to satisfy one subject area of the IGETC.
- 2. IGETC is not advisable for high-unit majors, e.g. sciences, engineering.
- 3. Revelle College at UC San Diego does not accept the IGETC.
- 4. IGETC may not be appropriate for students who have completed courses at a CSU or UC campus.
- 5. "Double counting" of courses toward the major is not limited by the IGETC, but may limited by other directives. The UC will also allow IGETC courses to count toward major requirements. CSU campus limitations on double-counting of general education courses toward major preparation are not changed by the IGETC.
