

## **Conditions of Financial Aid Awards**

## To receive financial aid at Gavilan College, I must comply with the following terms:

- 1. Comply with the Federal Pell Grant regulations, which prohibit a student from receiving Federal Pell Grant from more than one institution at the same time.
- 2. Enroll in an eligible program leading toward a certificate, degree, or be in a program that is acceptable for transfer. The certificate program should be at least 16-semester units long.
- 3. Enroll in at least a Less than 1/2-time status per semester to receive a Federal Pell Grant (if eligible). Additionally, if eligible, enroll in at least six (6) units per semester to be considered for Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants (SEOG), Federal Work-Study, CAL Grants, and Loans.
- 4. Award amounts on my Award Letter (except for CCPG) may be reduced based on my enrollment status. In some instances, I may become ineligible for the grant(s) if I do not maintain full-time status (12 units).
- 5. My eligibility for financial aid depends on my maintaining Satisfactory Academic Progress according to the standards of Gavilan College.
- 6. If I owe a refund on Federal Pell Grant and/or Federal SEOG or am in default on my Federal Loan, from any institution, I will not be eligible for federal aid and will be required to notify the Financial Aid Office.
- 7. If I receive financial aid and then withdraw from classes before the end of the semester, I may be required to repay all or a portion of the financial aid disbursed to me for that semester.
- 8. I acknowledge that the information provided on my financial aid application and other documents is true and correct. Gavilan College may verify any and/or all information. I will notify the Financial Aid Office of receipt of other financial assistance or resources.
- 9. I will promptly notify the Admissions and Records of any change of address, phone number, name, and drop or withdrawal from some or all classes.

- 11. If I receive a Pell Grant payment for Full-time (12 units), Three-quarter time (9-11.9 units), or Half-time (6-8.9 units), and I drop units, I may be required to pay back all or part of the grant.
